ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

INTERNATIONAL AMERICAN UNIVERSITY (hereinafter IAU) is Approved by the State of California Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education, Certified by the Student and Exchange Visitor Program (SEVP), accredited by the Transnational Association of Christian Colleges and Schools (TRACS), and a candidate for ACBSP accreditation of its business programs and for separate accreditation of its accounting program. TRACS and ACBSP are both recognized by the U.S. Department of Education, the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA), and the International Network for Quality Assurance Agencies in Higher Education (INQAAHE)

CALIFORNIA METROPOLITAN UNIVERSITY (hereinafter CMU) is a degree-granting institutions of higher education and has met the qualifications for exemption from regulation under the Act, under the California Education Code (CEC) section 94874 (b)(1). CMU is sponsored by the International Alliance of Business Professionals (IABP), U.S., a non-profit professional association.

The purpose of this agreement is to attest that IAU accepts, and continues to accept students from CMU's programs and/or credits from CMU unconditionally for its degree programs, per IAU's transfer credit policy.
