APOLLOS UNIVERSITY (hereinafter Apollos) is an approved private institution in the State of Montana accredited by the Distance Education Accrediting Commission (DEAC), and a candidate for accreditation by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools. DEAC and the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools are both recognized by the U.S. Department of Education, the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA), and the International Network for Quality Assurance Agencies in Higher Education (INQAAHE).

CALIFORNIA METROPOLITAN UNIVERSITY (hereinafter CMU) is a degree-granting institution of higher education and has met the qualifications for exemption from regulation under the Act, under the California Education Code (CEC) section 94874 (b)(1). CMU is sponsored by the International Alliance of Business Professionals (IABP), U.S., a non-profit professional association.

The purpose of this agreement is to attest that Apollos accepts and continues to accept students from CMU’s programs and/or credits from CMU unconditionally for its following degree programs: Bachelor of Science in Business Administration, Bachelor of Science in Sports Management, Master of Business Administration, Master of Science in Leadership and Management, Doctor of Business Administration, and Doctor of Strategic Leadership, per Apollos’s transfer credit policy.
